This position repairs or installs mill equipment, repairs or constructs building, repairs or maintains utilities. Operates machine tools to fine degree of tolerance (.0001”). Must supply own hand tools and measuring devices (reimbursement provided).

- May disassemble, overhaul by making up or replacing parts, reassembling, and trying equipment out.
- Pull motors, fix journals, fix bearings, turn commutators.
- Conducts sheet metal work, welds and brazes and works with wood when necessary. May paint as needed and able to perform pipe fitting or plumbing.
- Operates the various machines in the machine shop, to make or repair parts.
- Uses precision measuring instruments, reads blueprints and shop drawings.
- Perform repair work outside of the machine shop, such as setting and installing equipment and other maintenance of a precise nature.
- Operate machinery to shape metal parts to precise dimensions within the close tolerances specified.
- Operate machine tools and machine parts from a print and the ability to safely perform industrial rigging.
